Notes:

1-The term "*mufassal*" means the "last seventh of the Qur'aan," and it starts from *soorat* Qaaf (#50) to the last *soorah* of *An-Naass* (#114).

2-The longest of it is from Qaaf (#50) to soorat An-Naba' (#78).

3-The medium part of it is from soorat An-Naba' (#78) to soorat Ad-Duhaa (#93).

4-The shortest is from soorat Ad-Duhaa (#93) to the end.
